**Rules Chairman/Committee:** One of our members asked what would have been his options to when you tee shot lands in a green side bunker. Then you hit your second shot over the green into a water hazard. The players options are to Take a drop no nearer the hole from the point of entry of the hazard. Replay the shot from the bunker.

**Old Business:** We are all set to head to Palm Springs for May 25 – 28, and we have 18 members and 2 guests entered from the Vista Chapter. For those of you who are going, there will be no hospitality suit this year.

**New Business:** It was brought up that the yardage the club plays from in our chapter tournaments is based on a club rule that the slope determines which set of tees that we play from. The club rule is if the slope is higher than 124 from the blue tees, we will play the whites tees instead. In this particular tournament @ Eat Lake Golf course the yardage from the white tees was 5800 yards. The slope from the white tees were 118. The blue tees had a slope of 129 and yardage was 6200 yards. If the course plays under 6000 yards from the white tees, we need to play the blue tees. As it was on this last tournament, the white tees and blue tees were combined on several holes and most of the white tees were moved up on almost every hole. Thus, reducing the yardage even more below the 5800 yards indicated on the score card. There were remarks and comments that the majority of the players did not play well. But the score cards and handicaps for this tournament were calculated from the blue tees. So, our members aren't being correctly scored by the NET handicaps if we as a club aren't playing from the actual tees based on the slope. In the upcoming months the board will look into this to adjust the slope and to include the yardage to reflect equal and fair play for all members of the club
